5th Grade News

Fifth graders are in their third unit in ELA. In this unit, students will read literary and informational texts to determine how characters respond to the challenges presented by language barriers and ineffective communication. The main text for this unit is *Wonderstruck* by Brian Selznick. Students will express their understanding of this unit by completing their second narrative essay. They will also complete their second literary analysis essay at the end of the unit.

Students will be learning to add, subtract and multiply fractions and decimal fractions in math class. To begin, students will use modeling to create a deeper understanding of how fractions and division are related. Students will begin by measuring fractional parts on a number line as a concrete way of understanding fractional parts of a whole, and eventually move to more abstract fraction operations. Students will be able to solve real world problems involving fractions and mixed numbers.

In science class, students started Module 3: Earth Systems. The focus questions for this unit include: Where does fresh water come from? How do water and land interact? How do Earth's systems respond to change? Students will apply their knowledge of Earth's interacting systems to design and test a sustainable irrigation system.

In social studies, fifth graders will explore 17th century colonization in America. They will consider how colonization is a part of establishing a civilization. Students will research the first colonies to understand the characteristics of a civilization, why colonists chose to emigrate, and what is needed to successfully establish a civilization.
