In continuation of the notification referred above, the last date for payment of prescribed fees and the procedure for payment of fees is as notified below:

Payment of prescribed fee through on-line/e-payment without fine - **29.10.2020**

Payment of prescribed fee through on-line/e-payment with a fine –
of Rs. 200/- **05.11.2020**

1. The II/III year P.G. students of Bangalore University Departments/Colleges shall remit the prescribed fee as per the Notification on or before the dates mentioned above.
2. The payment of fees shall be paid through **ON-LINE/E-Payment** only and for details of payment visit the website: **www.bangaloreuniversity.ac.in**
3. The Chairpersons/Coordinators/Directors of the concerned Departments and Principals of the Constituent Colleges of Bangalore University shall direct their Office staff to verify the Caste/Income certificates as per the instructions mentioned in the fee structure. (Note: DD shall not be accepted).
4. The students who have admitted under Payment Category shall pay the payment Seat fees along with the prescribed/concession fees. Payment seat fees will not be reimbursed by the Social Welfare Department/Backward Classes Welfare Department/Minorities Welfare Department.

The concession under the prescribed fees is not applicable for the following students:

- The students pursuing Second Post graduation degree course.
- The students belonging to Outside Karnataka State.
- Where the students parent's annual income is above 2.5 lakhs in case of SC/ST/Cat-I category.
- Where the students parent's annual income is above 1.0 lakh in case of 2A,2B,3A & 3B category.
- In case of non-receipt of Fee reimbursement/ Scholarship in the previous year. (In case of such students, they may be directed to pay the prescribed fees and apply for Scholarship/ Fee concession for this academic year and if sanctioned, sanctioned fees amount may be refunded after receipt of the reimbursement).

The students shall be directed to submit the Fees receipt in the Department/College office.

Note:

1. The admission of Students to III/V Semester of the respective P.G courses shall be made only after the payment of dues if any, in the previous semesters are cleared by the students. (In case of students who have paid concession fee awaiting scholarship and in the case of students, for whom the scholarship have not been sanctioned)
2. The marks cards/ certificates shall not be issued/ countersigned/forwarded to the higher-ups until the dues are cleared by the respective student.
3. The Registrar (Evaluation) shall insist for NO DUE CERTIFICATE from the students issued from the respective department before issuing the Degree Certificate (only in the case of BU Departments/ constituent colleges students).
