United States Air Force Captain Kermit O. Evans, 31, of Houndale, Mississippi, was assigned to the 27th Civil Engineer Squadron at Cannon Air Force Base, New Mexico and served during Operation Iraqi Freedom. On December 3, 2006, Capt Evans and three other servicemen were killed when the Marine Corps OH-66 helicopter he was riding in made an emergency water landing in western Anbar province, Iraq. Capt Evans graduated third in his class from Simmons High School and went on to Mississippi State University, where he graduated with a degree in Civil Engineering in 2000. He enlisted in the Air Force in 2001 and was promoted to captain in November 2005. Capt Evans was an avid sports fan and athlete who was pleasant and giving, someone who liked to help other people. "He also had an inquisitive personality that probably landed him in his military career as an explosive ordnance disposal technician dismantling explosive devices," his mother said. "The Cannon EOD flight and EOD career field are going to miss a great leader, mentor and friend. Captain Evans' comrades will always remember the big smile he had on his face since setting off his first detonation. It never wore off," said Master Sergeant Kaller, 27th FW EOD flight chief. "He had it on every day he was here, no matter how mundane the task." Capt Evans' son is a Folds of Honor Scholarship recipient.

Kermit Evans Jr. attends a Private School in Mississippi. He enjoys basketball, rock climbing, video games, drawing, drums, and building Legos. Kermit can be described as funny, caring, kind, outgoing, smart, and extremely positive.
