SEEKING SALVATION AND CHOOSING COMPASSION

LUKE 10: 25-37

CENTRAL CHARACTERS: JESUS, SCRIBE (LAWYER), MAN FROM JERUSALEM, PRIEST, LEVITE AND SAMARITAN.

- I. Salvation described- a plan conceived before the foundations of the world.
 - a. Gift from GOD (Grace through faith not works), Ephesians 2: 8-9
 - b. Message especially for sinners- Mark 2:17
 - c. Salvation means death to and freedom from sin, Romans 6.
- II. Compassion described- sympathetic, pity and concern for the sufferings or misfortunes of others; “LOVE THY NEIGHBOR”
- III. OPEN DISCUSSIONS:
 - a. Jesus is our salvation and shows us that compassion and love are required of us even when we rather not.
 - b. Loving others requires us to go beyond our comfort zone, safe limitations.
 - c. When you find yourself in a difficult situation, who or what do you turn to for help? Why? Is this your usual first response? Explain
