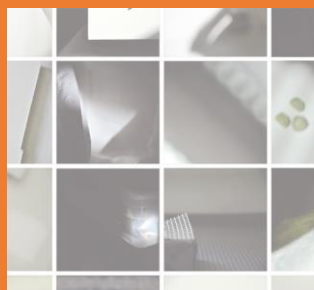
HELP Garden - For many years Guild Volunteers have
