

PORT OF BOSTON

Deportees Signed as Crew Ask to Leave Vessel Here

Thirteen Greek seamen and firemen who deserted their vessels at Philadelphia, arrested by the immigration authorities at that port and ordered sent out of the country, were signed as members of the crew of the Greek steamer Eugena Cambanis, which arrived here Monday, to load a cargo of grain for Piraeus.

Upon reaching here the men complained to the immigration inspector that conditions were not satisfactory to them on board the Cambanis and they asked to be taken off. They were transferred to the detention pen of the immigration station at East Boston. Four of them were put on the Norwegian steamer Songa, which left port yesterday. The others will be held until they are either signed on the crew lists of outgoing steamers or sent back to Greece.

The agents of the Cambanis are endeavoring to secure a crew to man the steamer on the passage from here.
