

2 Greeks Jump Ship, Wind Up On Breakwater

LONG BEACH (AP) — Two Greek sailors jumped off a ship anchored here and made a quarter-mile, cold swim to a breakwater Monday—only to find it wasn't connected to the main land.

The unidentified pair shouted and waved their arms in soaked clothing for two hours until they were picked up by a small craft.

The sailors told the Coast Guard they jumped the ship Captain Demosthenes because they didn't get along with the skipper. They were turned over to immigration authorities.
