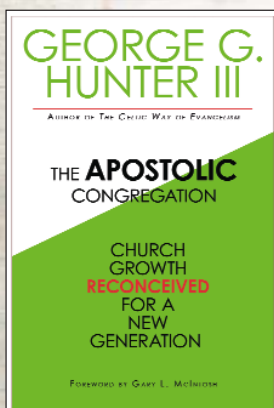


Spreading Contagious Disciples

From the 1st century to the 21st century, the key to church growth continues to be—disciples who actively spread the good news and reproduce themselves by making new disciples.



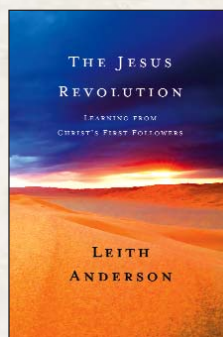
The Apostolic Congregation

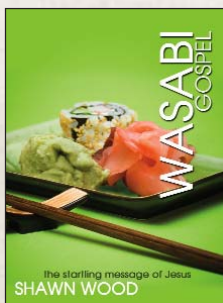
