E. Omnipresent - Acts 7:47-49

But Solomon built him an house. Howbeit the most High dwelleth not in temples made with hands; as saith the prophet,)Heaven is my throne, and earth is my footstool.

Holy -

Leviticus 20:7

Sanctify yourselves therefore, and be holy; for I am the Lord your God.

I Peter 1:16

Because it is written, Be ye holy for I am Holy.

Just and Fair - Romans 2:11

With God there is no respect of persons. Also Acts 10:34; Eph. 6:9; Col. 3:25; I Peter 1:17; Psa. 100:5 - and His truth endures to all generations.

H. Faithful - Romans 3:3-4

Shall their unbelief make the faith of God without effect. God forbid; yea let God be true and every man a liar.

Benevolent - Psalms 100:5

For the Lord is good and his mercy is everlasting and his truth endures to all generations.

Where is God?

Acts 7:49 - *Heaven is my throne and earth is my footstool.*

Matthew 5:34 - Jesus says heaven is God's throne.

Hebrews 5:13 - *Neither is there any creature that is not manifest in His sight, but all things are naked and opened unto the eyes of him with whom we have to do.*

What is God's Name?

Gen. 22:14 - Jehovah-jireh called the name of that place Jehovah-jireh.

Ex. 17:15 - Jehovah-Nissi The Lord is my banner -Hebrew *And Moses built an altar called the name of it Jehovah-Nissi.*

Judges 6:23-24 *And the Lord said unto him (Gideon) Peace be unto thee; fear not: thou shalt not die. Then Gideon built an altar there unto the Lord and called it Jehovah-shalom (My Peace).*

2. Who Wrote The Bible - II Peter 3:-1-2

This second epistle, beloved, I (Peter) now write unto you; in both which I stir up your pure mind by way of remembrance: That ye may be mindful of the words which were spoken by the holy prophets; and of the commandment of us the apostles of the Lord and Savior.

4. Inspiration - II Timothy 3:17

That the Man of God may be perfect thoroughly furnished unto all good works.

6. Purpose in Giving Us the Bible?

Jesus said - Matthew 4:4 *It is written man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that precedes out of the mouth of God. Also to help to us how to serve Him.*

7. What Use Should We Make of the Bible? II Timothy 2:15

Study to show thyself approved a workman that needed not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.

B. Blessed - Deuteronomy 28:1-12-14

If thou shalt hearken diligently unto the voice of the Lord thy God, to observe and to do all his commandments, which I command thee this day, that the Lord Thy God will set thee on high above all nations of the earth.

Second half of v.13 -

If thou hearken unto the commandments of the Lord thy God, which I command thee this day, to observe and to do them

D. I John 1:9

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteous.

What is the Law?

Romans 5:12-13

Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin, and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned. For until the Law sin was in the world; but sin is not (imputed when there is no law put on account).

Leviticus 20:7 Tells us to be holy for the Lord God is holy.

Deuteronomy 28 Tells us hear and do His words and His commandments.

John 10:9

I am the door; by me if any may enter in, he shall be saved and shall go in and out, and find pasture.

I Cor. 1:21

For after that in the wisdom of God the world by wisdom knew not God, it pleased God by the foolishness of preaching to save them that believe

11. (B)

John 14, 15, 16 Chapters teaches us to ask God for help but there are conditions, we must follow there.

James 4:2-3 v2

Ye have not because ye ask not. Ye ask and receive not because ye ask amidst, that ye may consume it upon your lusts.

12. (B)

I John 1:9 Tells us we are cleansed from all unrighteousness.

(C) God said Isaiah 57:19 - We create the fruit of the lips by speaking the word of God we can see His word is action. Ephesians 6:10-18, Phil. 4:13 (I Can), Phil. 4:19 (My God)

We are to be labors in the harvest of the Gospel.

Eph. 6:15 always carrying the Gospel, feet shod.

Mark 16:15-18 *Go ye into all the world...*

13. James 5:13-15

If any sick, call elders, any afflicted, pray the prayer of faith shall have the sick and the Lord shall raise him up.

1. The Hebrew - "Bereeth" (Gr.) to make league with by cutting

- C. Psalms 105:
He hath remembered his covenant forever, the word which he commanded two thousand generations. Heb. 8:6 a better covenant. Heb. 12:24 Jesus is mediator of the New Covenant.

2. 39 books in Old Testament, 27 books in New Testament, 66 books in all. God spoke to Abram when he was 90 years old and said in Gen.17:1-35
Walk before me, and be thou perfect. And I will make my covenant between me and thee, and will multiply thee exceedingly As for me, behold, my covenant is with thee, and thou shalt be a father of many nations. neither shall they Name any more be called Abram, but thy name shall be Abraham, for a father of many nations have I made thee.

3. Also contain prophecy's of the Christ Isaiah 61:1
The spirit of the Lord is upon me, because the Lord hath anointed me to preach the good tidings unto the meek, he hath sent me to bind up the broken hearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound. Isaiah 53:4-5 (read)

6. Their customs, even what they wore.

8. Genesis 1:26-27
And God said, Let us make man in our image after our likeness. v27 So God created man in His own image.
This shows God in Hebrew entity. The Hebrew word for God is Eloheim - plural noun. Until Jesus came, the internal unity of the Godhead was not understood to a great extent.

9. Inspired by God or Holy Spirit, written by man.

10. Adam had no limited brain capacity (UCLA study).
The New Testament is Old Testament revealed.

11. The general Hebrew word for truth or truthfulness and faith or faithfulness is from the verb Aman - Aman in the passive means, to be firm and established. The American version Bible in Deut. 28:66, means to have assurance.

- II Timothy 2:15 *Study to show thyself approved.*

12. I Thess. 4:16-17 *-For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first v17 Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up*

together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the Air; and so shall we ever be with the Lord Aman or Amen.

I Cor. 15:52 - In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump; for the trumpet shall sound and the dead shall be raised in corruptible, and we will be changed.

In the world ye shall have tribulation, but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world.

John 8:32 - Know the truth and the truth shall make you free.

4. Preaching I Cor. 1:21 -

5. We know, that we know, that we know - by the inner witness of the Holy Spirit.

6. Because the written words of Jesus tells us so.

John 1:12 -

But as many as received him to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on His name.

John 14:6,

Jesus said I am the way, the truth, and the life, no man cometh to the Father but by me.

B. John 5:39

Search the scriptures; for in them ye think ye have eternal: and they are they which testify of me.

8. Iniquity - Webster Lexicon of English language calls iniquity - great injustice or wickedness Hebrew dictionary - "aw-vone" fault, perversity, mischief. Iniquity from Hebrew word "eval"- (Aval) Evil - (evil) perverseness.
11. John 14:15 - *If ye love me, keep my commandments.*
14. John 16:33 –
These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation; but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world.

Anyone guilty of blowing off at anyone first say father forgive me, then ask others to forgive you.

4. David's Psalms 23 (read from Bible)
19. I Peter 2:24 - were, "past tense".
