Developmental screening is a free service for all children residing in the Four Rivers Special Education District. Screening is provided for children ages 2½ through 5, who are not yet enrolled in kindergarten. The screening identifies children who may have medical, speech, vision, hearing, learning, motor, or social/emotional needs.

After the screening, the results will be provided to the parents/guardians through the mail. The outcomes will result in the following recommendations: no concerns, monitoring by teacher (potential delay in an assessed area), further speech/language screening, or a referral for a comprehensive evaluation.

Due to COVID-19, we will be following specific health guidelines during the developmental screening as follows:

- * Individuals who show any signs or symptoms of illness should stay home.
- * Please arrive at your scheduled time. If you arrive too early, we may need to ask you to remain in your car until your scheduled time. We will be limiting the number of people in the building during screening times.
- * One adult to accompany your child will be allowed on the date of screening—NO extra people will be allowed in the building during the screenings.
- * On arrival, you will be asked to use hand sanitizer.
- * Please bring a mask to wear for you and your child while in the building.
- * Please stay 6 feet apart from others while waiting for your child to complete the screening.
- * Our staff will be wearing masks and we will be using hand sanitizer and also Clorox wipes to keep the testing areas and waiting areas clean.
