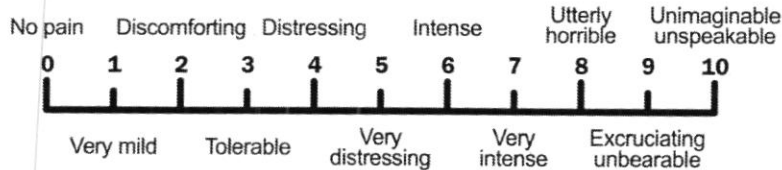
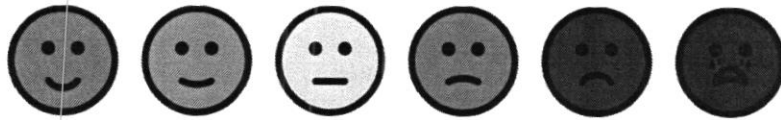

_____ (Narcotic medication)

Dosing: _____

Q: When should I be taking the medication?

A: Only as needed when pain is at a level 5 and climbing higher

Gabapentin _____ **mg**

Dosing: _____

Q: What is this medication for?

A: Usually used for anti-seizure, Gabapentin has been shown to provide great pain relief and is taken to help with sleep.

Valium (Diazepam) _____ **mg**

Dosing: _____

Q: What is this medication for?

A: Used to treat muscle spasms that commonly occur at the neck, shoulders, back and along the rib cages that can cause sensation of pain.

Tylenol _____ **mg**

Dosing: _____

Max dosing: 4000 mg/day

Q: What is this medication for?

A: Used to treat pain and is alternated with Ibuprofen

Ibuprofen _____ **mg**

Dosing: _____

Do NOT take with empty stomach

Q: What is this medication for?

A: Used to treat pain and is alternated with Tylenol
