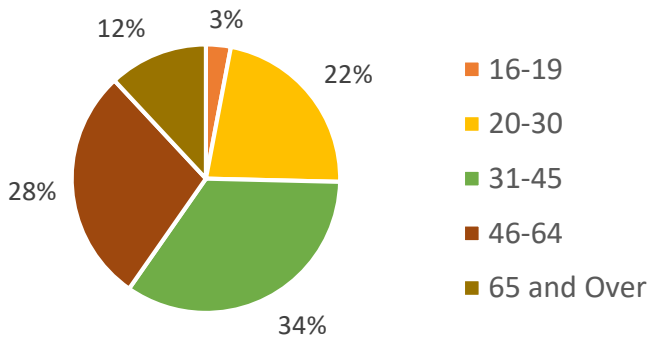




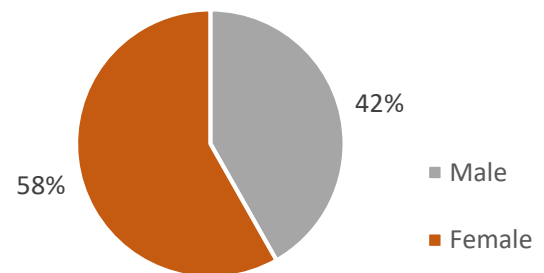
Grandmother's Bay – Survey Response Summary

Respondents Age:



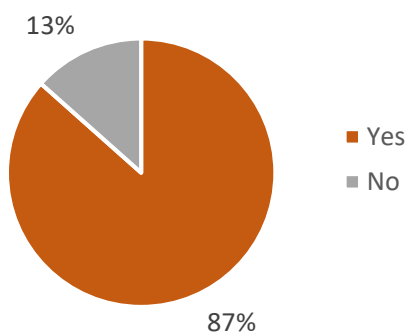
Respondents Gender:

Respondents that speak their traditional language:



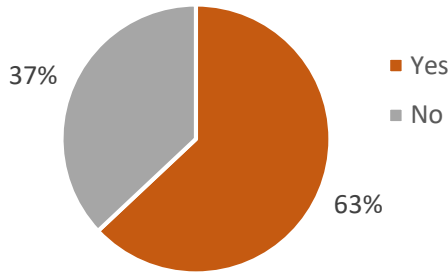
Which cultural events/programs/services would you like to see in your community?

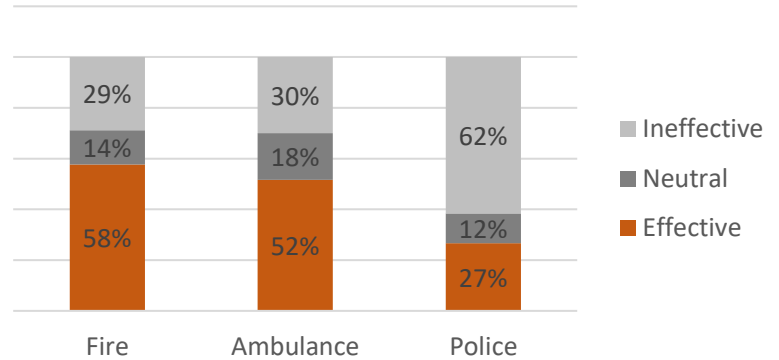
What could be done to improve health services/programs in your community?

How effective are emergency services in your community?



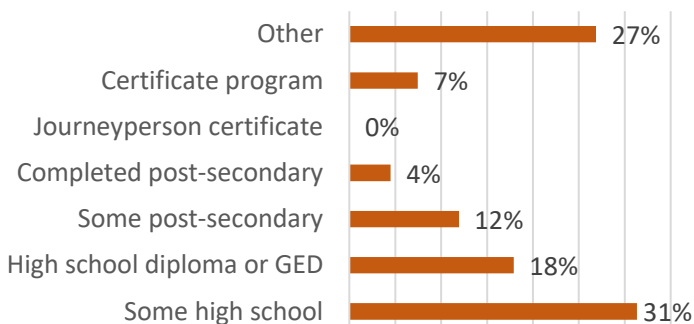
What are your concerns with emergency services in your community?

- Sports programs i.e. hockey, volleyball, soccer, swimming, indoor track, etc.

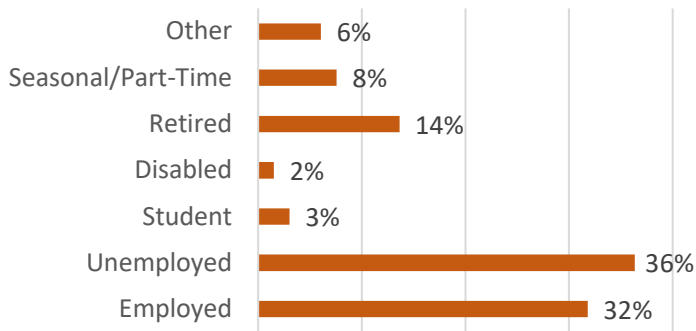
Respondents Highest Level of Education:

Respondents Employment Status:



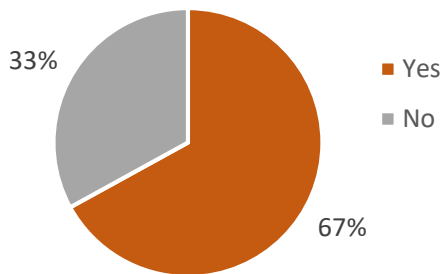
Are there barriers or problems to acquiring training or employment?

- Lack of jobs available in Grandmother's Bay

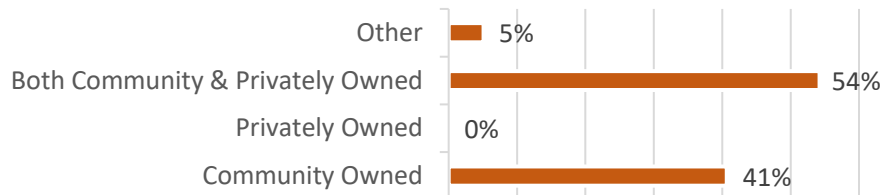
What improvements could be made to community infrastructure and services?

Are you comfortable with resource exploration and extraction on community owned lands?



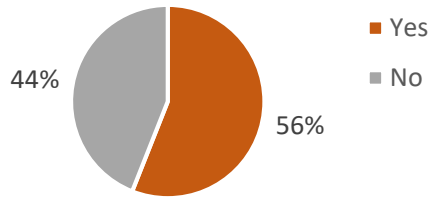
What types of commercial enterprises should be allowed in the community?



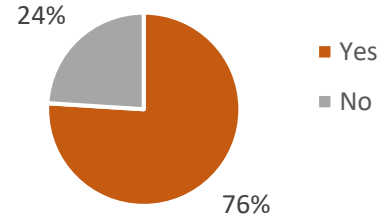
What commercial enterprises would you like to see the community invest in?

- More housing

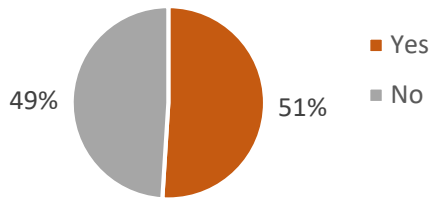
Does your current housing situation meet you, or your family's needs?



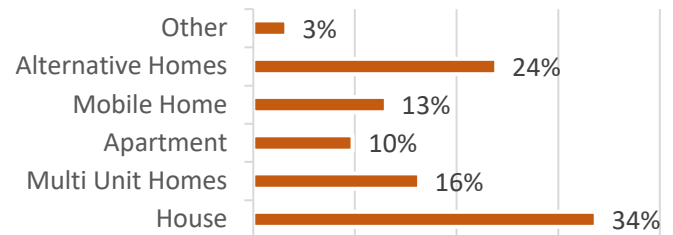
Are there repairs or renovations required in your home?

What other housing types would you like to see offered in your community?



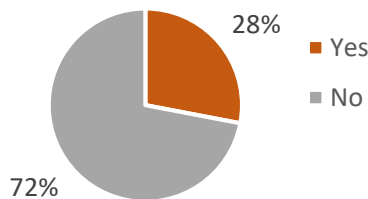
What policies or bylaws should leadership focus on developing in the short term (3-5 years)?
