

## COASTAL BEND YOUTH SOCCER ASSOCIATION 2021 HIGH SCHOOL MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIPS

Coastal Bend High School Seniors,

The Coastal Bend Youth Soccer Association (CBYSA) coordinates youth soccer activities in the Coastal Bend region and is dedicated to promoting the sport for children from ages four to eighteen. Part of our mission is to promote the ideals associated with soccer, which include teamwork, community involvement, and of course athleticism. As part of this endeavor, CBYSA annually honors high school seniors that exemplify these ideals by awarding college scholarships that are funded by our annual Thanksgiving Tournament.

Each year, applicants complete the attached form and provide the required transcripts, essays, and letters that are then reviewed by a CBYSA committee. The applicants are ranked and up to four scholarships are typically awarded.

The top ranked female applicant will receive the Canon L. Swim Memorial Scholarship. Canon Swim started playing soccer at age 6 at FC Padre. She played at Santa Fe Youth Soccer club for the SF Sharks and helped her team win back to back STYSA Spring Cup first place titles in 2016 and 2017. She then moved on to play for SF Fire helping her team come in 2nd place in Spring Cup 2018. As a freshman she was set to play varsity soccer for CC Veterans Memorial High School. Outside of soccer she was an A honor roll student taking advanced courses. She was first chair in the band playing the alto saxophone. Canon ran track and received numerous medals. She was an avid surfer and hunter. She exemplified all aspects of participation in soccer, as well as community service that CBYSA seeks to honor. Not only was she a star soccer player, but she was a USSF referee and helped with field maintenance and was highly involved in volunteering inside and outside of soccer.

The top ranked male applicant will receive the Cooley/Gonzalez Memorial Scholarship. Gabe Cooley, attended Calallen High School and played Club Soccer for Dynamo-CB. Gabe moved to Corpus Christi in the Summer of 2019. He was described by Calallen High School Coach McGinnis as "Hardworking and determined to achieve his goals." Gabe received several awards while living in the Coastal Bend including being named Outstanding Place Kicker Calallen HS Varsity Football and he was named the 2020 District 29-5A Soccer Newcomer of the Year. Gabe lost his life tragically while protecting his girlfriend and other shoppers at Walmart. Joel Gonzalez was a graduate of Rockport-Fulton High school and played Club Soccer for Dynamo for 5 years. He was a dedicated Player, Referee and Student. He "always encouraged other on and off the field." Says Express/Dynamo-CB President DeeLynn Torres. Joel played for Tri-City, GPSA, STXFC, Titans and Dynamo-CB. He was a Certified Referee for the Coastal Bend area over 5 years. He was also named the 2020 Most Valuable Player District 30-4A, and the 2020 4A All State Defender. He passed one month after his brother, Stephen from cancer. Both Gabe and Joel were model athletes and demonstrate the qualities of what we look for in honoring our Student Athletes within the Coastal Bend Youth Soccer Association.
