4. Prayer Ministry Launch

Can you participate in our Prayer Ministry at FBCHHI. While our Wednesday prayer emails will continue to go out and we encourage you to continue in your 10:02 Prayer each day, we are rolling out some new facets of this ministry. Beginning the weekend of November 20-21, we invite you to participate in one or all of these facets of our prayer ministry:

Saturday Evening Prayer Walking

- Each Saturday, we will gather for a casual and brief time at 6:30 pm for individuals to prayer walk inside our sanctuary and around our campus. This will be nothing formal, but simply a time for individuals and families to pray over our campus and those who will attend worship on Sunday morning. As many have said, "Sunday morning church is a Saturday night decision." No signup is necessary...just show up.

Sunday Morning Prayer Time

- At 8:00 am Sunday mornings, we will gather with whoever desires in the Student Building to pray over 2-3 emphases that fit the sermon passage for that day, as we pray over God to move in our services and classes. We will start together promptly at 8:00, and then within 10 minutes, we will break up to pray around the campus. No signup is necessary...just show up.

Intra-Service Prayer Warriors

- During each worship service, we invite 1-2 people to sign up on a rotation of prayer warriors who will come together in our Church Library in the Office Building to pray through provided emphases, focusing on what God is doing as they pray in the worship service and particularly approaching the invitation. There will be a list of prayer needs focusing on the spiritual needs (as many physical needs are addressed on our Wednesday list) for these Prayer Warriors to pray through. These Prayer Warriors are encouraged to sign up for one service per month, and it can be an individual praying solo, couples, or pairs of individuals of the same gender. This person then, if interested, can join us for worship in the other service that morning. Our goal is to have enough people signed up to have each person in this position only one time per month. This would require roughly 8-16 individuals. Due to scheduling, we do need to sign up for this. So, if interested, please contact Paulette to be put on the list.
