

*****QUARANTINE NOTIFICATION*****

Due to a positive case of COVID-19 in your student's classroom, a contact tracing investigation was initiated. Based on those findings, your student was identified as having close contact with this case. Below you will find dates of interest regarding your student's exposure and quarantine options.

Due to recent changes in the Ohio Department of Health's quarantine protocols, parents/ students have options for quarantine. **Please choose from the following options, and notify the School Nurse of your choice so appropriate accommodations can be made:**

In-school quarantine: Students may continue to attend in person learning, but must wear a mask for the 14 days following the exposure while attending school. Students may continue to attend as long as they remain symptom free.

At-home quarantine: Students/parents also have the option to quarantine at home, and work remotely through their chosen quarantine period. At home quarantine offers the following options:

1. The optimal duration to minimize the risk of transmission is a 14 day quarantine, **OR**
2. Ten days in quarantine WITHOUT testing, **OR**
3. Seven days in quarantine **AND** a negative test result on day 5 (or later) after exposure. Students who choose the 7 day quarantine must provide a written negative test result **BEFORE** returning to school.

Quarantine Dates:

(These are the dates your student should wear a mask and monitor for symptoms, regardless of the quarantine option they have chosen.)

LAST KNOWN DATE OF EXPOSURE:

(This is the date you were exposed to the positive case)
