Benefits Enrollment Centers help low income Medicare eligible seniors and persons with disabilities identify and apply benefit programs.

You may qualify for additional help with one of the following programs:

- Medicare Part D Extra Help/Low Income Subsidy (LIS) program-pays for Part D plan premiums, reduces drug co-pays and eliminates the Donut-Hole
- Medicare Savings Program(MSP)- These programs may help pay Medicare Part B premiums, deductibles and co-insurance.
- SNAP- Assists with affording the cost of food at supermarkets, grocery stores and farmers' markets.
- Medicaid- A comprehensive health care benefit package, including preventive care, primary care and specialist visits, hospital care, behavioral health services, dental services, and prescription medications.
- LIHEAP-Assists with lowering the cost of heating your home.
