**MY WINDOW NORTH**

*Well*, we were on our way. All three of us were making this trip as a “pilgrimage”, which means that we put it into God’s hands. We only had ten days to accomplish my objectives. The main objective was to fly to the village of McGrath in the Fairbanks Diocese, just north and west of Mt. Denali (the Great One) or Mt. McKinley as some people know it. From there, they asked if I could fly into an even smaller village called Takotna. They hadn’t seen a priest in 3 years. So it would take 3 days to fly to McGrath if the weather cooperated, then 3 days to return to California. That left 4 days to spend in the interior of Alaska flying to the villages or a day or two down time because of the weather. I told them we would leave on the 6th, overnight in Washington, overnight in Juneau and we could be in McGrath on the 8th, but plan on the 9th just for weather.

That was a very good idea as it worked out. We checked the weather and we were off at 8:30am Friday August 6th and flew 3 hours to Medford, Ore. for fuel. We passed over the San Joaquin Valley, which is the only way to travel that boring stretch of California. Our thoughtful “steward” had brought Tuna sandwiches which tasted very good as the plane was being fueled. We checked weather for our next stretch of about 2 ½ hours to Friday Harbor. There were clouds on the way and we made an “instrument approach” through the clouds over Puget Sound. Approach control was asking us to follow difficult intersections (where guidance signals intersect). I was trying to locate them on the map and J.Bruce was looking for them on his GPS. Finally together we worked it out, descended, saw the airport and landed. I opted to land there as the

church was just off the runway, but so was a motel. Good thing, as the priest wasn’t there.

The Harbor was not too far away and we had a great meal and celebratory beer. Remember you cannot have any alcohol 8 hours before you fly. Even though we wouldn’t be flying for at least 12 hours, J.Bruce elected not to have a drink. Both Mike and I toasted him. We had a great view, a great meal and a wonderfully cool walk back through town to the motel. I planned to have mass in my room at 6am to start our “pilgrimage”. So we had to be up and packed before that. I had the altar ready, all the articles necessary and my altar server and lector arrived early. What a beautiful way to start. We dedicated everything to the hand of God. We had their continental breakfast (very filling-not knowing when we would eat next).

We checked weather: 2 options; Up the coast with a fuel stop in Ketchikan: thick clouds to 10,000 feet, or interior: through British Columbia which was laced with thun-

derstorms. We found that the freezing level (ice) was at 12,000 feet along the coast. Thunderheads towered over 30,000 in the interior. So the coast was the way. Ketchikan was overcast, but it was high enough that we could drop down and see the runway. Juneau was the same. We fueled and were on our way. It is such a beautiful area to see from the air, Vancouver, Vancouver Island, all the Coast Mountains with glaciers, etc., but we couldn't see a thing; we were either in the clouds or they covered the mountains all the way to Juneau. What a disappointment. We landed and got fuel at Ketchikan, got a hot dog at the terminal through a little doggie door because of security. I thought that was appropriate, a hot DOG through a doggie door.

eau. This is where it was really important to have two people in the cockpit. The approach into Juneau was complicated. There is one runway, one way in and out of the airport, with commercial and private planes landing regularly. They had to "fit" us in on the approach. They told us to hold at the VOR (a navigational aid defined by our instruments) on the south side, right hand turns. Then exit that VOR on the published mag-

netic heading. I had the chart and was communicating the direction, timing and turns to J.Bruce. What a team. He flew the plane beautifully. We came down, descended below the clouds and there was the most beautiful sight of the Airport and Mendenhal Glacier just off to the right. God is good. And we were only beginning. Much more was to be experienced and revealed. We landed with a great sense of accomplishment. We called Tony Yorba, yes, Marge's son, who lives there. We would stay with them the night. We would meet them at their home, but after a visit to the "Twisted Fish" below the Tram, where I know they brew Alaskan Amber. We might see them around 5pm. We had to celebrate our arrival in Alaska appropriately. But there was more...






