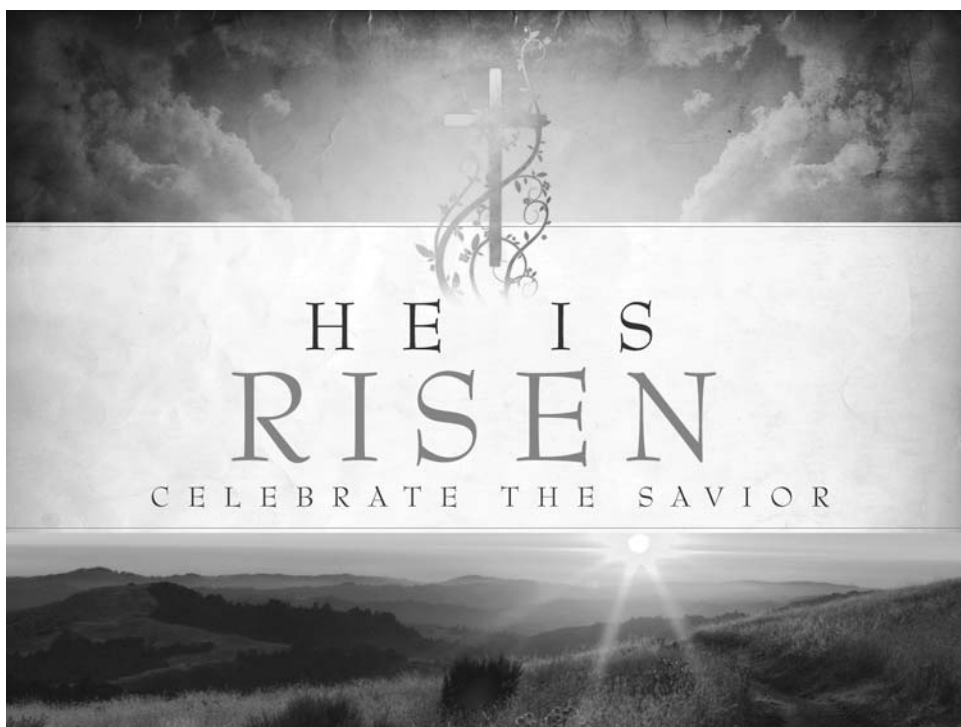


DRAWN INTO THE STORY

“We are witnesses!” The scripture readings for Easter Sunday concentrate on details reported by eyewitnesses. Listen carefully and you will be drawn into the stories yourself. Peter reports the good works Jesus did, his death on the cross, and his resurrection. The passage from John’s Gospel has us running to the empty tomb with Peter and John and peering inside to see the cloths used to cover Jesus’ body. Psalm 118 sums up our response: “It is wonderful in our eyes!”

What resurrection details do we see in our lives today? How have we died to our old lives and been raised up again with Jesus? Let us pay attention to the new life around us. It is wonderful in our eyes.

Domingo de Pascua: la Resurrección del Señor

Este es el día en que actuó el Señor, sea nuestra alegría y nuestro gozo. ¡Aleluya! En este Año Jubilar de la Misericordia la Pascua continua siendo la victoria de Dios misericordioso que levanta a Jesús “el testigo fiel, el primogénito de los muertos y el soberano de los reyes de la tierra” (Apocalipsis 1:5), “el primogénito entre muchos hermanos” (Romanos 8:29), venciendo a la muerte en todas sus formas, en todos nos nosotros en la familia humana. En el Evangelio de la Vigilia, este año el de Lucas, mensajeros celestiales enviaron a las mujeres a anunciar (24:6). En el Evangelio de Juan, la tumba vacía igualmente “envía” a María Magdalena, Pedro y el Discípulo Amado, quienes creían aunque no entendían plenamente. Por último, en la tarde de este domingo de Pascua, el Evangelio de Lucas que cuenta la historia de Emaús, nos envía como “misioneros de misericordia”, asegurándonos que encontraremos al Señor Resucitado, hoy y cada día en “la persona desconocida” que encontramos en nuestro camino de la vida, en la “Palabra que hace que arda nuestros corazones” y “al partir el pan” (ver Lucas 24:32, 35).

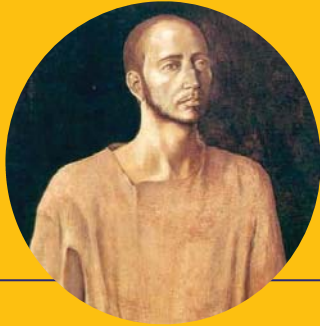
JUBILEE YEAR OF MERCY²⁰¹⁵₂₀₁₆

Easter Sunday: The Resurrection of the Lord

This is the day the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad. Alleluia! Easter is always, but especially in this Jubilee Year of Mercy, the victory of God's gentle but invincible mercy raising up Jesus, “faithful witness, the first-born of the dead” (Revelation 1:5), “first-born among many brothers [and sisters]” (Romans 8:29), conquering death in all its forms, in all of us in the human family. In Luke's Vigil Gospel, heavenly messengers send the women forth: “Remember what [Jesus] said to you” (Luke 24:6). In John's Gospel, the empty tomb likewise “sends forth” Mary Magdalene, Peter, and the Beloved Disciple, who believe though they do not fully understand. Finally, Luke's evening “Emmaus” Gospel sends us forth, as “missionaries of mercy,” assuring us that we will encounter the Risen Lord, today and every day, in “the stranger” we meet along life's journey, in “the Word that makes our hearts burn within us,” and “in the breaking of bread” (see Luke 24:32, 35).

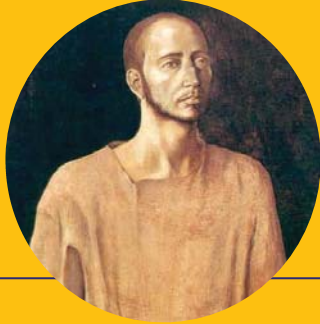

Sau ngày Chúa chịu chết, các môn đệ rơi vào một tình trạng thê thảm: buồn rầu, sợ hãi, chán nản, thất vọng. Còn đâu niềm vui khi được ở bên người Thầy yêu dấu. Còn đâu an ủi khi thấy những người đói khát được ăn no, người bệnh tật được chữa lành, kẻ tội lỗi được tha thứ, người chết được sống lại. Còn đâu niềm hy vọng tràn trề khi chứng kiến ma quỷ bị xua đuổi.

Tất cả đã chìm vào quá khứ. Giờ đây sự ác đã chiến thắng, sự dữ đã thống trị. Cả một bầu trời tang tóc phủ trùm trên những người tin Chúa. Tâm hồn các ngài như đã chết. Niềm tin yêu hy vọng của các ngài như cùng bị chôn táng trong mộ với người Thầy yêu quý.

Giữa lúc ấy, Chúa sống lại khải hoàn. Chúa Giêsu Phục Sinh đã khiến cuộc đời các ngài thay đổi tận gốc rễ.

Khi tảng đá lấp cửa mộ tung ra cũng là lúc tâm hồn các ngài thoát khỏi màn đêm vây phủ. Khi gặp được Chúa Phục Sinh, tâm hồn các ngài bừng lên sức sống mới. Máu chảy rần rần. Tim đập rộn ràng. Mắt sáng. Miệng tươi.

Các ngài như người đã chết nay sống lại. Chúa Giêsu đã Phục Sinh tâm hồn các ngài. Sự sống mới của Chúa đã tràn vào các ngài. Ơn Phục Sinh đã được ban cho các ngài. Sự sợ hãi đã trở thành mạnh dạn. Sự yếu đuối đã trở nên mạnh mẽ. Sự thất vọng đã biến thành hy vọng. Nỗi sầu khổ đã biến thành niềm vui.

Cảm nghiệm ơn Phục Sinh rồi, các môn đệ không còn có thể ngồi yên trong căn phòng đóng kín cửa nữa. Các ngài mở tung cửa, hăng hái ra đi đem Tin Mừng Phục Sinh chia sẻ cho mọi người. Các ngài muốn vực dậy những mảnh đời đang chết dần mòn. Các ngài muốn phục hồi những tâm hồn đang héo úa. Các ngài muốn thế giới biến đổi trong một đời sống mới, tươi vui, hạnh phúc, dồi dào hơn.

Hôm nay Chúa muốn cho tất cả mọi người chúng ta, noi gương các Thánh Tông đồ, tiếp nối công việc của Chúa, đem ơn Phục Sinh đến với mọi người.

Có những người đang chết dần mòn vì không đủ cơm ăn áo mặc. Có những cuộc đời tàn lụi đi vì bệnh hoạn tật nguyền. Có những tấm thân gầy mòn vì lao lực vất vả. Có những cuộc đời trẻ thơ bị giam kín trong tăm tối thất học, nghèo nàn. Tất cả đang đợi chờ được Phục Sinh.

Có những tâm hồn đang ủ rũ vì buồn phiền. Có những mạch máu như ngừng chảy vì đau khổ. Có những trái tim đang tan nát vì bị phản bội. Có những cuộc đời cay đắng vì thất bại. Có những tương lai bị chôn kín trong những nấm mồ đen tối

không lối thoát. Tất cả đang đợi chờ ơn Phục Sinh.

Nhất là có những tâm hồn đang lún sâu trong vũng lầy tội lỗi. Có những linh hồn đang tự huỷ hoại trong đam mê tiền bạc, quyền lợi, danh vọng. Có những niềm tin héo úa vì lạc hướng. Có những đời sống đang rỉ máu vì chia rẽ bất hoà. Có những cuộc đời đang chao đảo vì gặp khó khăn thử thách. Tất cả đang đợi chờ ơn Phục Sinh.

Đem Tin Mừng Phục Sinh đó là giúp cuộc đời anh em thoát khỏi những bế tắc, giúp cho linh hồn anh em được sống cao thượng và khôi phục niềm tin yêu của anh em vào Thiên Chúa, vào con người và vào cuộc đời.

Tuy nhiên, để có thể đem Tin Mừng Phục Sinh đến với mọi người, bản thân ta cần được Phục Sinh trước.

Trong chính bản thân ta cũng đang chất chứa những mầm mống chết chóc đó là những tội lỗi, đam mê, dục vọng. Trong chính bản thân ta cũng đang áp ủ những lực lượng tàn phá đó là thói kiêu căng, ích kỷ, chia rẽ, bất hoà, tham lam, bất công. Trong chính bản thân ta đức tin đang héo úa, lòng mến đang nguội lạnh, niềm hy vọng đang lụi tàn.

Để đón nhận được ơn Phục Sinh và để ơn Phục Sinh có thể thấm vào mọi ngõ ngách trong tâm hồn, ta phải cộng tác với Chúa, tẩy trừ mọi lực lượng sự chết ra khỏi tâm hồn ta. Cuộc chiến đấu sẽ khốc liệt vì ta phải chiến đấu với chính bản thân mình. Nhưng với ơn Chúa Phục Sinh trợ giúp, chắc chắn ta sẽ toàn thắng. (ĐTGM Giuse Ngô Quang Kiệt)

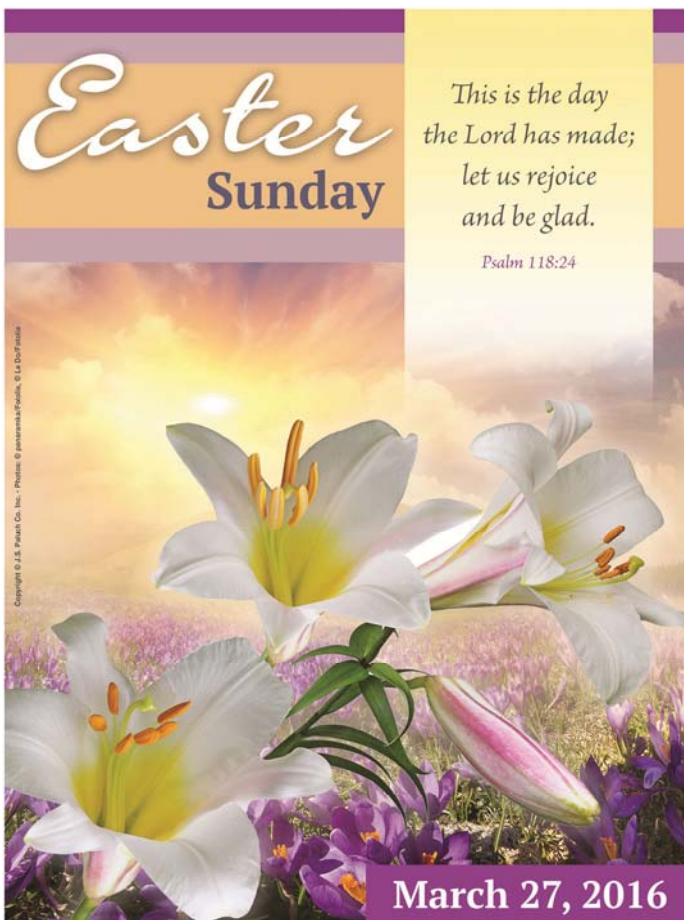

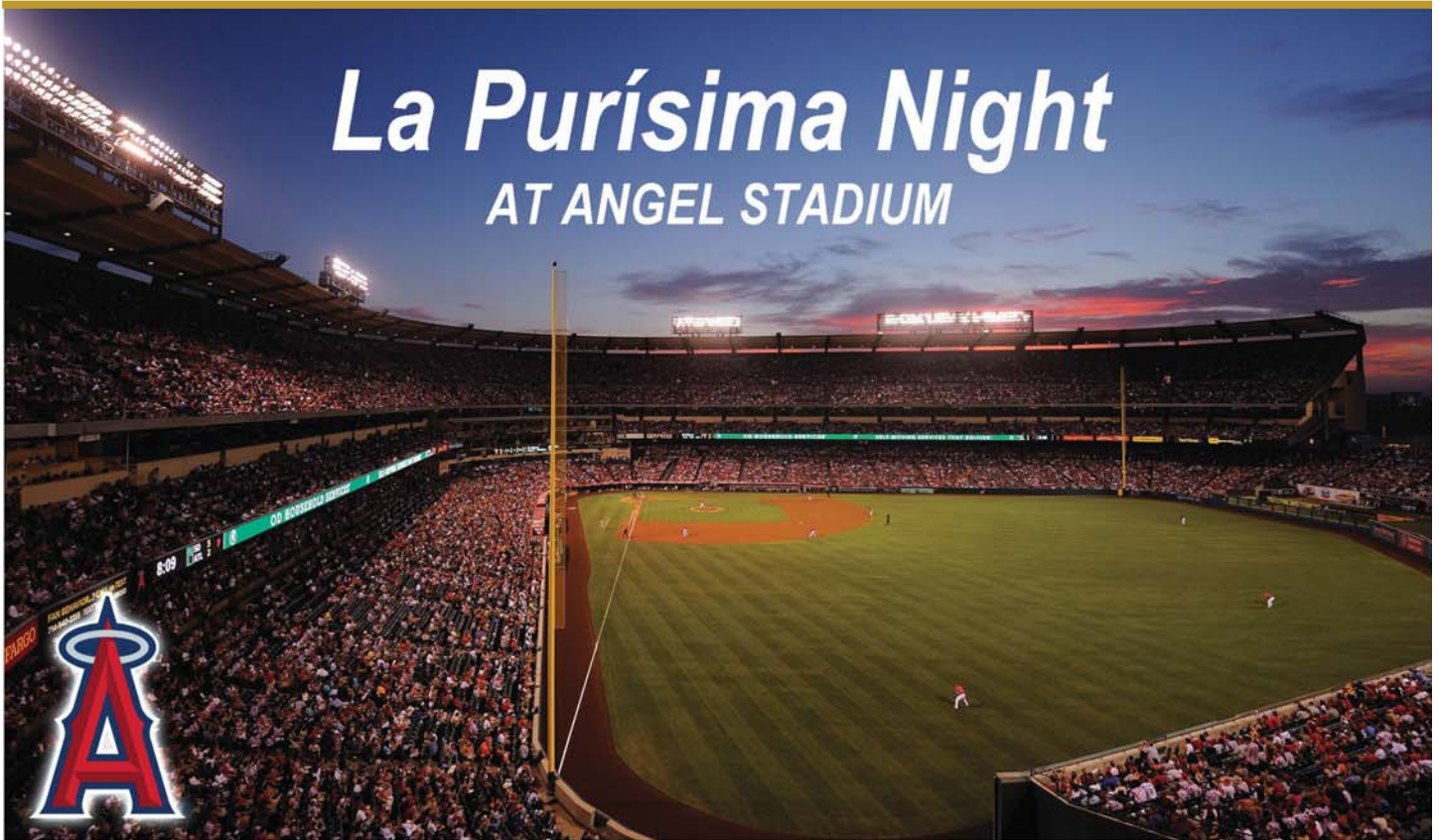

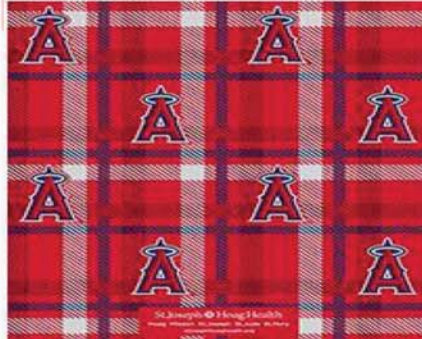
