

Visitation Guidelines: Indoor Visitor's Lounge

Reservations

- Visitation will be reservation only to ensure safety and staffing.
 - o At this time, we would like to make reservations for indoor, outdoor while weather permitting, and window visits.
 - If choosing the outdoor table, while weather permitting, please see Outdoor Table Guidelines.

Hours of Visitation

- Please make reservations at least a day in advance.
- Visiting hours will be reserved between the hours of 9:30am – 11:45am and 1pm to 4:45pm, Monday - Sunday*.
- Visits are limited to 45 minutes in duration to allow for transportation to the location as well as proper disinfecting in between visits.*
- With the limited amount of visitation reservations available, the facility reserves the right to deny frequent visit requests to allow for fair distribution of visits for all the residents.

Parking: Back Entrance

- The indoor visits will occur in the Visitor's Lounge located at the back of the building.
- Once on our property, you will notice a narrow driveway leading to the back. Please follow it entirely to the end, where you will see the back entrance. You may park anywhere in that area but please be mindful to try to make space for other vehicles.

Who can visit?

- We are allowing (1) ONE resident at a time to be visited by maximum (2) TWO adults*
 - o Because of the limited spacing, the following is the requirement for children:
 - If a child is able to sit in a stroller (not provided), then the child is permitted to visit.
 - If a child is not able to sit in a stroller, then the child is counted in the (2) TWO adult limitation.
 - It is the family's responsibility to ensure that all children cooperate and remain in the "safe zone".
 - o Anyone under the age of 18 must be accompanied by at least (1) ONE adult.
- Because of the limited reservations, the maximum number of visits allowed per resident per day is (1) ONE. *

During the Visit

- Visitors are asked to arrive early and **call the facility (631) 368-9528 prior to arrival**
- Upon entry, visitors will be greeted by staff who will complete the following:
 - o A health-screening form which includes having temperature taken.
 - o A sign-in sheet which includes stating your name, address, phone number, and if possible, email address.
 - o Each individual visitor will have to fill out the forms and be done with every visit, regardless of frequency.
- Visitors will be seated inside an enclosed space created by transparent wall dividers as well as 6ft distance between the resident and the visitor. This is to ensure proper social distancing during the entire duration of the visit as well as to not permit visitors to leave the designated space.
 - o **There is NO PERSONAL CONTACT WITH RESIDENTS of any kind.**
- Visitors and residents must wear masks/proper face covering during the entire time of the visitation.
 - o If a visitor does not have a proper face covering, it will be provided for them. However, with limited Personal Protective Equipment, please try to remember to bring your own.
- Restrooms are not permitted for visitor use at this time.
- Any visitor who fails to follow these protocols will be prohibited from visitation for the remainder of the COVID-19 declared emergency.
- The facility reserves the right to modify our guidelines as necessary and will provide updates.
