Drama reinforces the **BSE**ian's characteristics of **eloquence** and **enjoyment**. Pupils learn to express themselves openly and with confidence, speaking their minds and making themselves heard.

At **BSE** pupils are encouraged to:

- develop a sense of self worth through a constructive theatrical learning environment
- respect and have consideration for each other by practicing turn taking, enjoying each others' performances
- advance their creative imagination through a range of dramatic methods and activities
- refine their abilities to work constructively as members of a group, using skills of leadership, discussion and negation, to critique drama
- to enhance their skills of script reading and writing, through structured activities
- practice proficient stage skills, through rehearsing and performing in front of a live audience
- acquire a sense of theatre etiquette when attending or performing a professional theatrical performance
