2007 Edna Valley Chardonnay Wolff Vineyard

Winemakers notes at release: Fall 2008

2007 was a classic year from this mature thirty-year-old vineyard. The grapes were harvested in October because of the cool, maritime climate, and this long growing season gives the wine firm structure and beautiful acidity with buoyant aromas of citrus zest, gardenia flower and toasty nuance. Aged for nine months in French and American oak, this chardonnay is full and rich on the palate reflecting its old-vine, barrel fermented, *sur-lie* approach. The finish is long and complete.

As is our tradition, we make this wine as a singular vineyard and have since 1985.
