Statistics from 2012 showed that 15.4 million caregivers provided an estimated 17.5 billion hours of unpaid care, valued at more than \$216 billion. These illnesses affect over 35 million people across the globe, and that number is expected to double every two decades.

Previously, memory-related diseases were noted as the sixth-leading cause of death. More recently, it was discovered that as far as contributing to death, memory-related diseases may be among the ranks of heart disease and cancer. In fact, actual death rates related to memory problems may be almost six times greater than originally recorded. The reason is that death certificates only report the immediate cause of death (for instance, pneumonia); they do not record underlying causes. However, if someone's immune system is already compromised with mental decline, fighting off pneumonia is much more difficult.

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Taking all of the underlying factors into consideration can drastically change the final picture.
