Concerns:

- No school nurses on site
- After School Hours for Medications
- Evacuations – Safety and Emotional/Physical well being
- Reunification Process
- Responsibility/Access to proper Medical care if needed on/off site when Parents/Guardians are not reachable
- Proper training to handle complex medical conditions
- Better collaboration with Parents/Guardians on students' medical needs
