Code of Conduct

SSLC has an international reputation for providing a high standard of quality education. In order to maintain that standard at all times, all students attending SSLC must agree to, and follow, SSLC rules and policy during their studies here.

1. Students must abide by Canadian laws and by the rules of SSLC including English Only, attendance, bullying, fighting, and academic misconduct policies.
2. Students must use only drugs prescribed by a doctor, and are not allowed to purchase or consume alcoholic beverages.
3. Students are not permitted to travel outside of their host city unless they are accompanied by a responsible adult, and have natural parents' permission *in writing* as well as permission from their host family.
4. Students are not permitted to take time off school unless given permission by the school and their natural parents.
5. Students in homestay must follow the homestay family rules.
6. Students must show respect for their teachers, administrative staff, and director of the school.
7. At school, students must:
 - ❖ Attend every class and required activity
 - ❖ Be punctual and demonstrate good behaviour in class
 - ❖ Be responsible, show interest and complete homework / assignments

English Only Violations

English must be spoken at **ALL TIMES** inside the school **AND** around the building including washrooms, classrooms, hallways and the computer lab. Students who use their native language will receive an English Only Warning.

Students **MUST** use only English on all computers between the hours of **9am and 3pm**. Students caught using their native language on a computer will receive an English Only Warning.

1st English Only Warning: Students will be **DISMISSED** for 1 day from class and assigned in-school assignment

2nd English Only Warning: Students will be **DISMISSED** for 1 week from class and assigned in-school assignment
Students will not receive a certificate

3rd English Only Warning: Student will be **REMOVED** from the program at SSLC, but must be at the school at 8:45.

Attendance

Students who are absent from class put themselves behind in their progress in learning English. Students who are absent from class are responsible for the material covered in the lesson. It is not the Teacher's responsibility to provide the missing material.

- Students must arrive on time for all their classes throughout the day.
- If a student is more than 10 minutes late for a class, they will not be allowed to join the class *and* will be marked **ABSENT**.
- Students who are absent from a class 3 times (or late 6 times) will receive a warning.

Student Behaviour

All students at SSLC have the right to learn without disruption or distraction from other students.

- **If a student's behaviour in class is disruptive** such as sleeping, not follow a teacher's instruction, not showing enthusiastic studying attitude and the behaviour is disruptive, the student will be removed for the remainder of that class and will receive a Warning. The student will not be permitted to enter class for the remainder of the day.

In order to maintain a healthy learning environment, students are expected to show respect towards their classmates, SSLC staff and SSLC's equipment and facilities at all times.

SSLC reserves the right to immediately expel any student for the following reasons:

- **Student's conduct disrupts the educational activities, services or events provided by SSLC for students or members of the community;**
- **Student's behaviour could cause harm to a person, SSLC's property or the property of others;**
- **Student's behaviour or conduct is unlawful.**
