PUBLIC WORKSHOP – LCB File R049-16

The State of Nevada Board of Registered Environmental Health Specialists is proposing the addition, amendment and/or repeal of regulations pertaining to Chapter 625A of the Nevada Administrative Code.

The purpose of the workshop is to solicit comments from interested persons on the proposed regulation LCB File R049-16. The proposed regulation makes changes to the procedures for application for and renewal of a certificate of registration as an environmental health specialist or environmental health specialist trainee; interprets the term “basic science courses”, requires notification to the Board of a name change, requires certain communications and documents to be address to the Board, establishes certain fees, defines the term “environmental health sciences”, revises requirements for continuing education and provides other matters properly relating thereto.
