

The Permian Basin Area Agency on Aging, through funding from the Texas Health and Human Services, can assist you in determining if you qualify for Extra Help and/or Medicare Savings Programs. Bilingual staff is available to assist with the following:

EXTRA HELP with Medicare Prescription Drug Plan Costs: If you have limited resources and income, you may qualify for Extra Help with costs related to a Medicare prescription drug plan:

- Monthly Premium
- Annual Deductibles
- Prescription co-pays
- Closes coverage gap (donut hole)

MEDICARE SAVINGS PROGRAMS are programs that help individuals with limited income and resources pay some or all of their Medicare premiums and deductibles:

- Part B Monthly Premium
- Skilled Nursing Facility Copayment
- Part A Hospital Deductible and Copayments
- Part B Annual Deductible and Copayments

MEDICARE PREVENTIVE CARE SERVICES: The new health care reform law has eliminated co-pays and deductibles for most preventive care services covered by Original Medicare. Medicare beneficiaries are eligible to receive free preventive care services:

- Annual Wellness Screening
- Welcome to Medicare Physical Exam
- Vaccinations: Pneumonia; Flu and Hepatitis B
- Screenings: Cardiovascular; Osteoporosis; Diabetes; Breast, Prostate, Cervical and Colon Cancer
- Medical Nutritional Therapy
- Smoking Cessation
