

SUMMER CAMP NOTES

We are back to a full summer camp schedule this year but there are still some Covid precautions in place. All of these are subjected to change per updates from the Ohio Governor.

Cabin sizes are limited to 10 occupants (including kids and counselors).

Large group gatherings will be limited to mealtimes and chapel. Other activities will be done in cabin groups.

Meals will still be served via a buffet line but it will served by the staff, not self-serve.

Chapel and Bible studies will be held outside at the amphitheater while cabin groups stay socially distant.

COVID FAQs

Are masks required?

Masks are required indoors (not in their own cabin) when multiple cabin groups are present. Masks are not required at the table during mealtime or outdoors.

Are Covid tests required prior to Camp?

Tests are not required but there is a general Covid questionnaire that is required. It can be found by clicking the "Forms" tab on our website home page.

Will there be daily temperature checks?

Yes, we our camp nurse will conduct daily temperature checks for all campers and staff.

What happens if someone has a temperature of exhibits other Covid signs?

Anyone with a temperature will be isolated and monitored by the camp nurse. Those with persistent conditions will be sent home and asked to undergo a Covid test.

Was summer camp fun negatively impacted last year due to Covid precautions?

Camp was great last year! We successfully and safely had 2 weeks of camp, 1 week of day camp, 2 weeks of SWAT, and 1 week of family camp last year. We operated with the same precautions and everyone had a great time.

Are there any summer program changes due to social distancing requirements?

All of Camp's regular activities are available. Large groups games like Capture the Flag and Bible Smugglers are currently on hold so most activities are done in cabin groups. We try to do as much as possible outdoors to limit the need for masks and social distancing. Our new Maple Inn patio allows plenty of space to properly separate cabin groups at mealtimes. Shower times are scheduled by cabin group to limit congestion in the shower house.
