

CHAMPIONS FOR CHILDREN INSHORE FISHING CLASSIC

Tournament Format

Inshore Slam Category:

First, second and third place team awards will be determined by total length inches of one snook, one redfish and one trout. Each must be photographed on the official measuring device and sent via text to the tournament official (813-244-4682). Please include your team captain's name in your message. Upgrading slam species is allowed.

Biggest Snook. Biggest Redfish. Biggest Trout:

First place individual awards will be given for each slam species (snook, redfish and trout). Each must be photographed on the official measuring device and sent via text to the tournament official (813-244-4682). Please include your team captain's name and specific angler who caught the entry in your message. Upgrading slam species is allowed.

Kid's Overall Biggest Slam Fish

First, second and third place individual awards will be given to anglers 14 yrs old and younger who catch the biggest of any slam species. Each must be photographed on the official measuring device and sent via text to the tournament official (813-244-4682). Please include your team captain's name and specific angler who caught the entry in your message. Upgrading slam species is allowed.

General Rules

1. The "total length" means the length of the fish as measured (tail pinched - according to Florida Fish and Game regulations) from the most forward point of the head to the hindmost point of the tail on the measuring board.
2. No touching of fish in photos. Nose on board lip, pinch tail, let go and take photo.
3. Measuring boards will be issued to each team at the Captains Meeting. Photographs must be taken with your smartphone camera on the authorized measuring board. The team captains are responsible for the quality of the photos (which are subject to interpretation by the tournament officials). If the photos are not of such quality as to clearly represent the status of the fish, that entry may be thrown out. Send photos to officials by text and request verification.
4. Any team with excess of bait may share, if they choose.
5. There will be no transfer of Snook, Redfish or Trout between teams.
6. All tie breakers will be the time you submitted your fish. For the Inshore Slam category, it will be the time of the last photo sent.
7. If you witness a violation you must report it to officials.
