



## Individual Volunteers

Thank you for your interest in partnering with Dallas Afterschool. Due to COVID-19, our volunteer activities are limited to virtual opportunities. Below are a few ways you can help:

### Virtual Career Day

Volunteers will teach students about what they do for a living and how their work affects the world around us. Volunteers create a video using a list of suggested questions and prerecord a video based on their career. Each video should include a short three to five minute explanation of the career, and may include a virtual office/site tour or an activity to allow children to learn about the volunteers work.

Volunteers may also participate in a moderated panel discussion in real time using Zoom (optional). This interactive session will allow students to ask questions and further explore the careers presented.

### Back-to-School Supply Drive
