Course Description

MATERIALS LIST

If you wish to knit along during this demonstration, here is the Materials list needed to participate:

- Cut the following 4"x6":
 1. Top fabric - anything that you have and appeals to you
 2. Soft layer - batting or felt
 3. Cardboard (cereal box weight)
 4. Address fabric - white or pale colour - preferably 100% cotton
 5. Glue stick
- Embellishments can be added, but not essential - ribbon, beads, various threads, etc.

Equipment:

1. Sewing machine with thread
2. Or a hand sewing needle and thread
3. Iron
4. Scissors
