
SMALL GROUP



Questions:

- 1) We often confuse the word meek with weak. What is the difference between them? How does that understanding explain this Beatitude?
- 2) A big part of being meek is understanding that gentleness does not come with a lack of strength, but instead it comes from it. How can you be both gentle and strong? What are some examples of this in our lives?
- 3) We are told over and over again to be gentle, merciful, peaceful, etc. as Christians. What is the consequence if we are not? What happens to our message of salvation?

Memory Verse: Matthew 5:5 “Blessed are the gentle, for they shall inherit the earth.”

Monthly Challenge: Your challenge this month is to read through the Gospel of Matthew. If you have not yet begun, at least make sure you read through the Beatitudes and their context in chapter five before the day is done!

A NOTE FROM DODGE COUNTY FOOD SHELF

March FoodShare begins on Monday and we are grateful for your continued support. Because of COVID, we would prefer monetary donations this year. For every \$1.00 that is donated to the food shelf we are able to purchase roughly \$10.00 worth of food. If someone would rather donate food or personal care items, they of course are always welcome to do so.

We are open our regular hours: Tuesdays and Thursdays, 8 - 12:30 am and 1:30 - 4 pm.

We are focused on providing food to people safely by sanitizing, wearing masks, and social distancing. The food shelf averages 20-25# per person in a given shopping trip, which is about 10# more per person than a year ago.
