A double baptism will be held on May 23rd at KUMC for Lillian and Paxton Lunn.

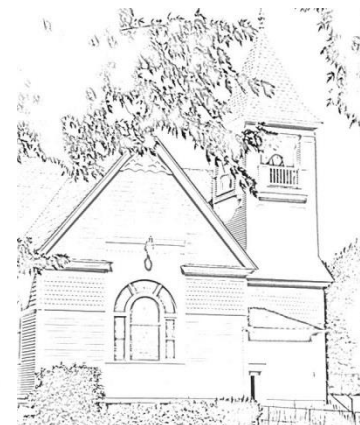
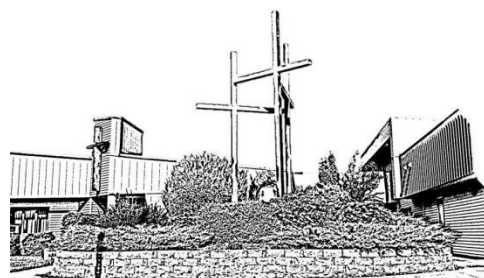
