The Lenora Church is on the National Register of Historic Buildings, and is a beautiful and inspiring place to come away on a Sunday afternoon to spend time in Christian reflection, prayer, and fellowship. The Lenora Church is a prime example of an 1800's era pioneer church building in Fillmore County.

Operation Christmas



Operation Christmas Child is a project through Samaritan's Purse, an international relief organization. Our church has been participating in this project for many years. We fill shoeboxes with toys, hygiene items, school supplies & Christian items which are sent to children across the globe. This a great way for our church

to be in ministry to others all around the world. The boxes are filled and delivered to a drop off site in November.

We pack 90 shoe boxes, 15 for each age group, Boys-ages 2-4, 5-9, 10-14 & Girls-ages 2-4,5,9,10-14. Donations of new items for the boxes are greatly appreciated; Washcloth, toothbrush, bar soap, socks,

small toys, balls, jump ropes, small stuff animals. coloring books, crayons, colored pencils, markers, combs, brushes, small water bottles/plastic cups.

A drop off box for donated items can be found inside the office entrance at KUMC. We cannot send any liquids, toothpaste, food items, or war-related items.

We also make items for the boxes in the OCC craft room in the Sunday School wing at KUMC. Homemade items are greatly appreciated. We have partnered with Prairie Meadows in the past receiving wonderful items they have made for the boxes.

Please consider being part of this ministry in the following ways: Donate items, make items- a list of what needs to be made can be found in the OCC craft room, be part of the Action Team for this ministry. There will be a meeting sometime this summer for members of this Action Team.
