About becoming a May Court Member

Volunteer Hour Requirements: Active and Provisional (new) members are required to give a minimum of 50 hours of volunteer service per year. There are two categories of service: community service and club service. Members are expected to participate in both areas of service.

Membership Fees: There is an annual membership fee that is reviewed every two years. Additional optional costs may be incurred for the purchase of May Court Club pens, bags, and aprons, and for club activities such as luncheons, and tickets to May Court Club events.

Process: Upon completion and submission of this application, the Membership Services Committee will interview you to review your application, discuss the May Court Club of Ottawa, its expectations and to answer any questions you may have. The first year of membership is a provisional year in which you learn more about the May Court Club, begin to volunteer in the community and on club committees, and participate in educational and social events. Upon successful participation during this year, you will become an Active member.
