

SUMMER SPLASH 2019 Rules and Waiver

All participants under 18 need to have a parent/guardian's signature.

1. Participants must have an official wrist band on in order to participate in any activity at the Summer Splash.
2. Participants must follow these rules and respect instruction given by staff and volunteers.
3. Participants with an open wound or who are actively bleeding will not be allowed on/in the water slides or bounce house.
4. Participants must be physically able to navigate on the slip 'n slides and bounce house.
5. Participants attempting to navigate on the slides and other activities must be courteous to others and take turns.
6. Participants must dress appropriately, as this is a family friendly event.
7. Shoes may NOT be worn on the slides. Water shoes are okay. No buckles or sharp objects will be allowed on the slides.
8. Do not let your very young children go on the slip 'n slides unattended. A toddler slide is available for the younger children; parents are responsible to watch their children in this area. Please do not leave your children unattended anywhere at the event.
9. All bikes and other wheeled devices are strictly prohibited near the slides. No flotation devices allowed.
10. Urinating or defecating on or anywhere is strictly prohibited. Restrooms are available for your convenience.
11. Several photographers will be stationed along the slides and at other areas within the park. Participants agree to allow the event sponsors to use any pictures of the event for future promotional purposes.
12. Any participant who disobeys instructions from any of the event volunteers is subject to removal from the event. This includes, but is not limited to, lack of respect, unsportsmanlike behavior, nudity, and offensive language.
13. Alcohol is strictly prohibited anywhere on the church property. Any participants or spectators found having or using alcohol will be asked to leave the premises immediately.

- 14. Staff reserves the right to examine anyone who they feel needs medical attention.
- 15. This is an extreme event. All participants must understand and accept the risks involved with participating in the event. All participants, and/or the parents/guardians of participants, assume all responsibility for any medical costs that may be incurred.
