**WORKSHOP MINUTES**

Tremont Borough Council held a Workshop at 6:30 p.m. in Clay Street's Municipal Building.

Council members attending: James G. Scheibley, Robert E. Donmoyer and Philip Kintzel. Also attending: Mayor Roger D. Adams and Fire Chief Brian Eisenacher. Citizens attending: Doris Hubler, Kathy Adams and Daniel Noll. Absent: Paulette M. Yuschock, Roger Adams

President/Road Supervisor Scheibley tested all the batteries in the emergency lights at the Clay Street Building and almost all of them are bad/dead. There is only one emergency light working in the whole building. Lewis Kohr said it's been years since they were replaced. There are five units and each unit takes four 6-volt batteries. Moyer Electronics' price is \$15.89 per battery.

Motion made by Kintzel, second by Donmoyer to purchase the batteries for the emergency lights. Roll call vote; all in favor.

President Scheibley read a letter that he received from Councilman Roger Adams today:
