**Tremont Borough Council**  
**REORGANIZATION MEETING**

Tremont Borough Council met for Reorganization at 6:30 p.m. in the Clay Street School Building.

Council members in attendance: James G. Scheibley, Robert Donmoyer, Philip Kintzel, William Ochs and Daniel Noll.

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Shea Lucas, Borough Secretary/Treasurer, opened the Meeting by introducing the newly elected Mayor, Ricky Ney Jr. Lucas presented Mayor Ney with his Election Certificate.

Mayor Ricky A. Ney Jr. administered the oath of office to newly elected councilman, William Ochs and re-elected tax collector, Cheryl Mack.

District Justice David J. Rossi administered the oath of office to re-elected councilman, James Scheibley and newly elected councilman, Robert Donmoyer, prior to the meeting.

Copies of election certificates, affidavits of residency, and original signed oaths will be placed in the borough file.

Mayor Ney opened the floor for nominations for Council President. Kintzel and Noll nominated Robert Donmoyer for President. There were no other nominations for President. The Mayor closed the floor for nominations and proceeded with a roll call vote for Robert Donmoyer for President; Noll-Yes, Donmoyer -Yes, Scheibley-Yes, Kintzel-Yes, Ochs-Yes. Mayor Ney requested the Secretary to reiterate the votes for Robert Donmoyer for President; Noll-Yes, Donmoyer -Yes, Scheibley-Yes, Kintzel-Yes, Ochs-Yes. Mayor Ney announced Robert Donmoyer as President of Council.

Mayor Ney then opened the floor for nominations for Council Vice President. Kintzel nominated James Scheibley for Vice President. Noll nominated William Ochs for Vice President. There were no other nominations for Vice President. The Mayor closed the floor for nominations and proceeded with a roll call vote for James Scheibley for Vice President; Noll-No, Donmoyer -No, Scheibley-No, Kintzel-Yes, Ochs-No. Mayor Ney continued with a roll call vote for William Ochs for Vice President; Noll-Yes, Donmoyer -Yes, Scheibley-Yes, Kintzel-Yes, Ochs-Yes. Mayor Ney requested the Secretary to reiterate the votes for both James Scheibley for Vice President; Noll-No, Donmoyer -No, Scheibley-No, Kintzel-Yes, Ochs-No, and for William Ochs for Vice President; Noll-Yes, Donmoyer -Yes, Scheibley-Yes, Kintzel-Yes, Ochs-Yes. Mayor Ney announced William Ochs as Vice President of Council.

At this time, Mayor Ney presented the gavel to President Donmoyer.

President Donmoyer opened the floor for nominations for Council President Pro Tem. Noll nominated Philip Kintzel for Council President Pro Tem. There were no other nominations for President Pro Tem. President Donmoyer closed the floor for nominations and proceeded with a roll call vote for Philip Kintzel for President Pro Tem; Noll-Yes, Scheibley-Yes, Kintzel-No, Ochs-Yes, Donmoyer -Yes. President Donmoyer requested the Secretary to reiterate the votes for Philip Kintzel for President Pro Tem; Noll-Yes, Scheibley-Yes, Kintzel-No, Ochs-Yes, Donmoyer -Yes. President Donmoyer announced Philip Kintzel as President Pro Tem. Kintzel will preside in the absence of both the President and Vice President.

The following actions were taken concerning appointments and reappointments:

Motion made by Kintzel, second by Scheibley, to retain Melissa Kelso as Borough Solicitor. Roll call vote; Noll-No, Scheibley-Yes, Kintzel-Yes, Ochs - No, President Donmoyer -Yes. Motion passed 3-2.

Motion made by Scheibley, second by Kintzel, to retain Shea Lucas as Borough Secretary/Treasurer. Roll call vote; Noll-Yes, Scheibley-Yes, Kintzel-Yes, Ochs-Yes, President Donmoyer-Yes. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion made by Scheibley, second by Kintzel, to retain Lettich & Zipay (formerly Patton & Lettich) as the Borough Auditor. Roll call vote; Noll-Yes, Scheibley-Yes, Kintzel-Yes, Ochs-Yes, President Donmoyer-Yes. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion made by Scheibley, second by Kintzel, to retain Light-Heigel & Associates as Borough Engineer and UCC Compliance Officer. Roll call vote; Noll-No, Scheibley-Yes, Kintzel-Yes, Ochs-Yes, President Donmoyer-Yes. Motion passed 4-1.

Motion made by Kintzel, second by Scheibley, to retain Schuylkill Municipal Authority as Borough Sewage Enforcement Officer. Roll call vote; Noll-Yes, Scheibley-Yes, Kintzel-Yes, Ochs-Yes, President Donmoyer-Yes. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion made by Scheibley, second by Kintzel, to retain Lewis Moyer as Borough Health Code Officer. Roll call vote; Noll-Yes, Scheibley-Yes, Kintzel-Yes, Ochs-Yes, President Donmoyer-Yes. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion made by Kintzel, second by Scheibley, to retain the Tremont Police Department as Code Enforcement Officers including enforcement of the Quality of Life Ordinance. Roll call vote; Noll-Yes, Scheibley-Yes, Kintzel-Yes, Ochs-Yes, President Donmoyer-Yes. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion made by Noll, second by Scheibley, to retain Miners Bank and PLGIT (Pennsylvania Local Government Investment Trust) as depositories for borough funds. Roll call vote; Noll-Yes, Scheibley-Yes, Kintzel-Yes, Ochs-Yes, President Donmoyer-Yes. Motion passed unanimously.

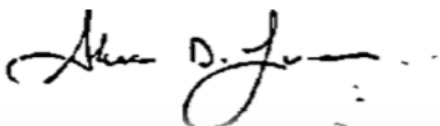
