Curriculum

Religion: We discussed in more detail the gifts of the Holy Spirit. We read the Sunday Gospel. The passages are about Jesus teaching and healing.

Vocabulary: We finished unit 8. Students were introduced to an infographic, a visual display of information. Students studied examples of infographics. They created their own about a strange animal. We started unit 9.

English-We finished up chapter 6. We learned how to write compound sentences using coordinating conjunctions and connective adverbs. We also finished our essays. The topic was to describe three possessions that are worth more than gold to them. The theme was inspired from a Shakespearean quote, "All that glitters is not gold." They did a wonderful job. I really enjoyed reading them. I would encourage you to read your child's essay.

Science-We finished chapter 4. We reviewed using our notetaking worksheet and chapter vocabulary review worksheet.

Reading-We finished our short-short, *The Jacket*. We did a walk-around discussion about what questions the book left unanswered and what made us think. Students are currently working on a one-pager assignment that focuses on characterization and theme. We started our new novel, *Roll of Thunder, Hear my Cry*.
