Ms. Aumann's Notes.....

Week 25.... We worked diligently this week....we enjoyed routine! My students worked through a lot of curriculum this week. It was a great feeling to be back in the swing of school. Confirmation is FAST approaching. We will be spending extra time discussing this important sacrament over the next couple of weeks.

Curriculum

Religion: We worked on Confirmation. The students have a supplemental resource for Confirmation. We read the first section and discussed how the Holy Spirit has been known since the beginning of time. Genesis 1:2. Father Rodney talked about the details of Confirmation with the students during his monthly religion class. We read the Sunday Gospel. Next week, Lent begins.

Vocabulary: We finished our cumulative unit. Students are working on a video vocab assignment. They have to do a skit of some kind that defines their chosen vocabulary word.

English-We worked on editing paragraphs. We learned how to combine sentences to help with the flow of a paragraph. We wrote compound and complex sentences. We will finish up our college essay next week.

Science-We finished section 2 in chapter 5. We discussed tropisms, plant hormones, and photoperiods. We also worked on our notetaking worksheet. Next week will be our chapter test. Mrs. LeVault demonstrated the importance of taking care of our Earth with a presentation called "Earth, the Apple of our Eye."

Reading-We have read five chapters in *Roll of Thunder, Hear my Cry*. The story line is building up to more conflict. Our characters are experiencing injustice at every turn in their lives. We worked on a journal prompt and questions.


