Curriculum Notes

Religion-We start in the middle of our book-chapter 21. It is the chapter that focuses on the Eucharist. It is the perfect place to start to remind us of the need for the Bread of Life. We worked on some workbook pages and added prayers to our class prayer list.

Vocabulary-We started unit 1. We discussed the unit's words with examples. We started the Vocab Jar activity. If your child sees, hears, or uses a vocabulary word-they say, "VOCAB WORD!" On Thursday, we tally up our vocab words and add pom-poms to our vocab jar for each one. When the jar is full, we have a pizza lunch! Be listening for your child to say "VOCAB WORD!"

English-We worked on our journal prompts and daily oral language. We took an online quiz to see what kind of learner we are-auditory, tactile, or visual. Ask your child about this.

Reading-We filled out our independent reading log and finished our short story, *Love that Dog*. We started a story map.

Science-We did an activity called "Dogs & Turnips." It was an activity that showed students the following: science can have many different answers, the importance of data, the need for background knowledge, and collaborative work.
