Curriculum Report

Religion-We reviewed chapter 20 with a Kahoot quiz. We took the test on Tuesday. We started back at the beginning-chapter 1-God's Creation. We read the Gospel to be prepared for Mass on Sunday. Matthew 25:31-36, 40 "*For I was hungry and you gave me food.*"

Vocabulary- The students worked on a writing response based on unit 5's story. We read a story about Joseph Merrick, known as the elephant man. He suffered greatly in his life with a physical disability. We discussed the gift of the Holy Spirit-Fortitude. The students wrote about somebody they knew that demonstrated the gift of Fortitude. Ask them who they wrote about.

English-We reviewed the steps in the writing process, the five types of writing, and the six writing traits. We finished our three-point expository paragraph on our favorite games.

Reading-We've read five chapters of *The Westing Game*. We are learning the characters-there are over 20 characters in this mystery book!

Science-We discussed scientific drawings and different types of graphs. We finished our chapter and worked on the chapter review.
