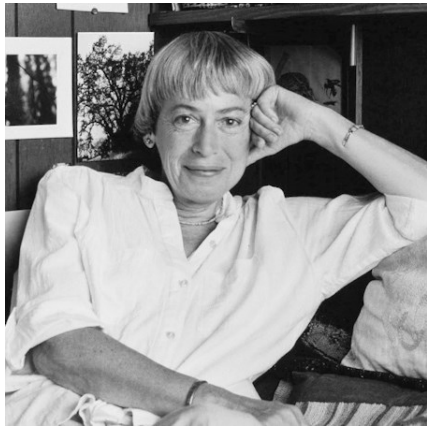


Worlds of Ursula K. LeGuin
