- Currently a 2019 high school senior planning to attend a 2 or 4 year college
- 2.5 minimum GPA
- Has community service/volunteer experience in **education/counseling/mentoring/tutoring/preschool or with special needs children**

- **Deadline for postmark is Friday, April 12, 2019.**

- The two scholarship recipients will receive a letter and a certificate from the Sixth District PTA.
