



## Woodland Soccer Club Board Meeting Minute

Wednesday, May 14, 2014

### **Discussions Points:**

1. Soccer Camp (June 16<sup>th</sup> week or June 23<sup>rd</sup>)
  - Sanaldo Carvalho proposed Summer Soccer camp at WSC.
  - Players will not be responsibility of the club
  - WSC needs to put in the field reservation and pay the costs \$250
  - Woodland High School may cost more and there are no bathrooms
  - Robert proposes to do it at the Woodland Community Center
  - Carlos C. mentions that the club should not lose money.
  - Fausto is concerned about mixing rec & comp kids.
  - It is decided by the board to expose this at the Club meeting and let the teams decide based on participation.
  - An estimate of possible camp players from each team was done: (Richard - 6; Fausto - 6; Marcos - 5 or 6; United 05 - 3 or 4; another team - 3 or 4; another team - 4 or 5; Chelsea - None; Mexico - None; another team - None).
  - With an estimated total of 25 to 30 kids, it was decided that it was not feasible to do the summer camp.
