For the "virtual" 2021 festival, we introduced a different scoring model on an experimental basis. Instead of awarding one Gold, one Silver, and one Bronze to the three highest-scoring participants in each track and shift within each category, we established score ranges corresponding to Gold, Silver, and Bronze award levels. Every student whose scores placed them in those score ranges received an award at that level. This model resulted in more awards in most categories compared to previous years.
