Annual EEO Public File Report

The purpose of this EEO Public File Report is to comply with Section 73.2080(c (6) of the FCC's 2002 EEO Rule. This report has been prepared on behalf of the Station Employment Unit that is comprised of the following stations: WBUT, WISR and WLER-FM, all licensed in Butler, Pennsylvania. Activities

Section 1: Vacancy Information

There were no open positions within the organization.

Section 2: Recruitment Source Information

A review of the sources used to advertise open positions was completed and no additions were recommended. Despite ongoing public service announcements, no additional requests for job postings were received from the public or community organizations.

Section 3: Supplemental Recruitment Activities

While the efforts in this area were limited by COVID-related restrictions and the cancellation of job fairs and in-person activities, the organization was still able to host an internship opportunity for one student in the areas of production, music and engineering. The student internship began in late January once the organization was comfortable having outside individuals in the facility.

The organization also was able to host two high school students who were interested in broadcasting for short shadowing opportunities in February 2021.
