City tour of Avignon – duration 4H

Explore the historical center of Avignon on a 3-hour walking tour with your English-speaking guide. Climbing up to the top of the fortified medieval city walls, discover Avignon stretching in all its beauty along the Rhône river. Discover the rich historical past of Avignon where the papacy established in the early 14C. Enjoy skip-the-line access and follow your guide inside the Pope's Palace (entrance ticket included), largest Gothic-styled Palace in Europe. In this maze of galleries, chambers and chapels, imagine its luxurious furnishing and sumptuous decoration from the medieval period.

Walking on the cobbled streets to the Place de l'Horloge, find out about the secret of the painted windows. See the Town Hall topped with its clock tower, and the theatre. Your tour will end up with a glass of Côtes du Rhône wine served in a historical place, mostly known by the locals.

Excursion All Provence In One Day

The most beautiful monuments and spots in Provence. Departure from Avignon to Roussillon built at the top of an ochre cliff, and providing visitors with a beautiful understanding of the harmonious combination of man and nature, and of ochre and stone ; with all these ochre-washed façades. Enjoy the market in Roussillon on Thursday. Continuation toward Gordes which is a village erected on the top of a cliff, its fortified castle and church dominate the typical houses of the village

which were built with stones from the rock on which they are fitting. Enjoy the market in Gordes on Tuesday. Drive to Fontaine de Vaucluse : walk up to the cave from which the River Sorgues emerges.

This impressive resurgence spring hasn't revealed its secrets yet and many speleologists have searched in vain the exact depth of the well.

Free time for lunch (not included) on your own in Gordes or Fontaine de Vaucluse. Continue to the Pont du Gard (entrance fees included) : visit the best preserved aqueduct of the Roman period, dating back to the 1st century and listed by UNESCO. Les Baux de Provence : photo stop and free time to visit this medieval village located on a rocky spur in the Alpilles mountain range, with its historical center, beautiful houses of the 16 th century, the Romanesque-styled St-Vincent Church. Photo stop at the Antiques in Saint Rémy de Provence (Triumphal Arch and mausoleum) located in an olive-tree field. On Sundays only, enjoy L'Isle sur la Sorgue, village famous for antique shops and the weekly open air market which is one of the most colorful and typical in Provence. The order of visits will then change on Sunday to include the stop at the market in Isle sur Sorgue.

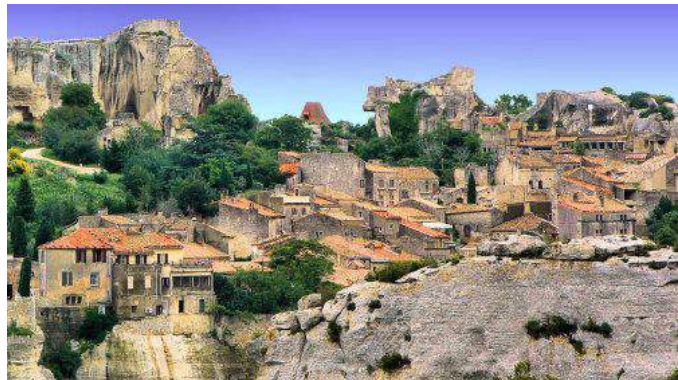

Excursion Olive & Wine In Les Baux

Admire Les Baux de Provence, medieval village labeled as "one of the most beautiful villages in France".

This immense and superb stone fortress is without doubt one of the "must-sees" on the Provençal tourist trail !



Taste olive-oil in a mill in Les Baux de Provence valley, one of the most beautiful landscapes of olive groves in Provence, where olive oil, cracked olives and black olives are entitled to the A.O.C. Label. The unusual feature of this A.O.C. olive oil is that it is made from a subtle blend of several varieties of olives, a secret jealously guarded by each producer that gives to the oils a whole palette of different flavours. Wine-tasting in an estate at the foot of the Alpilles hill range. The wines of Les Baux are defined by the unique, multi-faceted character of the soil, naturally protected and dried by the mistral wind. The Baux de Provence wines have been officially recognized since 1995 by a "Registered Designation of Origin" (Appellation d'Origine Contrôlée).
