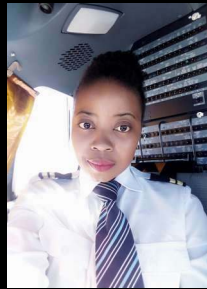


Live Virtual AVIATION CAREERS CAMP
