Garbage & Refuse Collection	673-2226	The City contracts out waste hauling, curbside recycling, & yard waste. Large items require pre-scheduling.
Gardens & Trees 	673-2226	The DPW and DDA along with the Garden Club, Master Gardeners, & Rotary Club maintain our gardens and trees. Volunteers are always needed.
Leaf Pick-Up	673-2226 	The DPW provides leaf pick-up in the Fall only. Please see city website & newsletter for timing information.
