

Reconstruction, Rehabilitation, Elevation, and Mitigation (RREM) Program

To be completed by ALL applicants, even if requested reimbursement is \$0.

On July 30, 2013, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) issued a Notice to allow for reimbursement to homeowners of eligible costs that they have already incurred to reconstruct, rehabilitate, elevate and mitigate their homes prior to the homeowner's initial inspection date.

Applicants/Homeowners may now receive a "reimbursement" payment for eligible work incurred before the initial site inspection provided the applicant attests that those costs are fixed to a contractual obligation executed prior to the date of the RREM Program application. This reimbursement payment may be taken in addition to the disbursement of construction costs upon completing the repair of their homes, up to the maximum award.
